**Genealogy Files** - (Filing Cabinet) Family histories. Arranged alphabetically in file folders contained in seven file cabinets.

**LeRoy Obits Vol. 1-5 Plus index** (Black binders on top of the filing cabinet) Older LeRoy Obituaries.

**Saul's Notes** – (Orange binders on top of filing cabinets) A large collection that contains information about where people in Genesee County are buried. Arranged alphabetically.
